



AMENDED JUDGMENT

Trial Date: 5/21/2012

15 This cause came on regularly for trial on May 21, 2012, in Department 22 of the above-
16 entitled court, The Honorable Robert McGuiness presiding. Plaintiff Candace Conti appeared by her
17 attorneys Richard J. Simons and Kelly Kraetsch, defendant The Watchtower Bible and Tract Society of
18 New York, Inc. appeared by its attorney Robert Schnack, and defendant Fremont Congregation of
19 Jehovah's Witnesses, North Unit appeared by its attorney James McCabe. No appearance was
20 made by defendant Jonathan Kendrick.

21 A jury of 12 persons was regularly impaneled and sworn to try the action. Witnesses on the
22 part of both plaintiff and defendants were sworn and examined. After hearing the evidence, the
23 arguments of counsel, and instructions of the Court, the jury retired to consider their verdict,
24 subsequently returned to Court, and being called, answered to their names and duly rendered their
25 verdict in writing, in words and figures, as set forth in the Special Verdict and Special Verdict-Phase
26 Two, true and correct copies of which are attached as Exhibits "1" and "2" hereto.

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1 Judgment having been entered on June 27, 2012, an Order Awarding Costs to Plaintiff in the
2 amount of \$30,199.58 having been entered August 16, 2012, the Court's Order Conditionally
3 Granting Motion for New Trial as to Punitive Damages having been made on August 24, 2012, and
4 Plaintiff's Acceptance of Reduction of Punitive Damages to \$8,610,000 having been filed on
5 September 17, 2012:

6 IT IS HEREBY ADJUDGED, ORDERED, AND DECREED that the Judgment in this matter is
7 amended and Final Judgment is hereby entered as follows:

8 IT IS HEREBY ADJUDGED, ORDERED, AND DECREED that Judgment is entered in favor of
9 plaintiff Candace Conti, and against defendants Watchtower Bible and Tract Society of New York, Inc.,
10 North Fremont Congregation, and Jonathan Kendrick, jointly and severally, in the amount of
11 \$130,000.00;

12 IT IS HEREBY ADJUDGED, ORDERED, AND DECREED that Judgment is entered in favor of
13 plaintiff Candace Conti, and against defendant Watchtower Bible and Tract Society of New York, Inc.,
14 severally, in the amount of \$10,464,900.00;

15 IT IS HEREBY ADJUDGED, ORDERED, AND DECREED that Judgment is entered in favor of
16 plaintiff Candace Conti, and against defendant North Fremont Congregation, severally, in the amount
17 of \$893,100.00;

18 IT IS HEREBY ADJUDGED, ORDERED, AND DECREED that Judgment is entered in favor of
19 plaintiff Candace Conti, and against defendant Jonathan Kendrick, severally, in the amount of
20 \$4,122,000.00;


22 IT IS HEREBY ADJUDGED, ORDERED, AND DECREED, that Judgment for costs is entered in
23 favor of plaintiff Candace Conti, and against defendants Watchtower Bible and Tract Society of New
24 York, Inc., North Fremont Congregation, and Jonathan Kendrick, jointly and severally, in the amount of
25 \$30,199.58;

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1 Plaintiff is further awarded post judgment interest as allowed by law.
